Why does Lynn use a Digital Toolkit?

The Digital Toolkit simplifies the purchasing of technology for our students and ensures that all students have the same resources in the classrooms and in their residence.

Do I need a Digital Toolkit?

The Digital Toolkit is required for the following programs:

A.S. in Graphic Design: (MAC ProBook or Dell Work Station)

B.F.A. in Computer Animation: (MAC ProBook or Dell Work Station)

B.F.A. in Graphic Design: (MAC ProBook or Dell Work Station)

B.F.A. in Film Production: (MAC ProBook or Dell Work Station)

B.F.A. Visual Art and Design: (MAC ProBook or Dell Work Station)

M.F.A. in Computer Animation

M.F.A. in Graphic and Web Design

M.S. in Digital Media or Web Design Technology specializations

Students who choose not to obtain the Digital Toolkit through Lynn will be unable to obtain support for their own laptop at the IT support desk.

Do all courses in the College of Communication and Design require students to have a Digital Toolkit?

How do I purchase a Digital Toolkit?

Is the Digital Toolkit cost covered by financial aid?

Yes, if you have a credit on your student account that exceeds your tuition costs that can cover the entire amount. Student must go to Student Financial Services department to be cleared for a Digital Toolkit pickup.

When will I get my Digital Toolkit?

Digital Toolkits can be picked up at the IT support desk in the Library after the drop/add period

I am a Data Analytics and Cybersecurity student with the College of Business Toolkit, can I use this toolkit in the College of Communication and Design with no additional cost?

You can use the Mac Book Pro. However, you will need to purchase accessories and software at your own expense.

What warranty and support should I expect with Digital Toolkit?

The Digital Toolkit laptop has a four year warranty against manufacturer defects. All accessories have a two year warranty. Support is available through the IT department on the first floor of the library.

Who is responsible for loss or damage of the Digital Toolkit?

Students are responsible for the safety of their devices. Students will be responsible to purchase all other accessories at their own expense. For a damaged Digital Toolkit not covered under warranty, the cost is the actual repair cost.
