Tuition and fees: These cost estimates are based off minimum yearly enrollment for each program. **Your actual tuition rate may vary depending on the number of credit hours you enroll in each term.** Due to program structure, some degrees require more courses each year to stay in sequence while others are more flexible.

Living Expenses: The following expenses are included in the calculations of living expenses for one year.

- **Off-campus housing and off-campus transportation:** Cost estimates are based on data collected and provided by [The Economic Policy Institute](#). The costs represent the average expenses based on local costs in Boca Raton and Palm Beach County.
- **Off-campus meals and dining:** Expenses shown are based on the Cost of Food at Home data published by the U.S. Department of Agriculture and are adjusted for the regional Cost of Living Index and inflation.
- **Health insurance:** All international students are automatically enrolled in and billed for the university health insurance plan. Insurance is included in the cost estimate for Living Expenses.
- **Personal expenses:** These costs are based on the [U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics Consumer Expenditure data for the Miami Area](#), and are adjusted for inflation.

Athletes: If your scholarship covers tuition, housing and meals, you will still need to show funding for insurance and living expenses besides housing and meals. The amount you show is based on the cost estimates for transportation, health insurance and personal expenses. For 9 month programs this is **\$14,824** and for 12 month programs the estimate is **\$19,924**. If insurance is included in your scholarship, deduct \$2,150 from this amount.
