

# New to Lynn Student Housing Selection

## Important dates and details for new students

The following information is for new to Lynn University students for the 2023-2024 academic year. Please read the timeline below to ensure you complete the necessary steps to be eligible for your space within University owned or operated facilities next year. December 16, 2022: [Housing Application Opens on \*lynn.erezlife.com\*](#)

- All students interested in living within University owned or operated facilities for the 2023-2024 school year must apply for housing.
- Please note: Lynn University expects students who have completed less than 60 credit hours to live and board within the University residential system. For more information on the housing policy, please [click here](#).
- Students can begin creating their roommate profile to connect with other new students and possibly find a roommate match through the eRezLife portal once their application is complete.
- While we try to accommodate all roommate groups and room type preferences, housing assignments are based on a first come, first serve basis. Housing spaces on campus are limited; once spaces are full, the University will assign students to a University managed offsite hotel.

- Students applying for ADA accommodations must also fill out a housing application.

June 1, 2023: [Roommate Group Deadline](#)

- In order to be considered for your roommate group, you must create a roommate group by June 1, 2023.
- We do our best to accommodate all roommate groups, however, it is not guaranteed. For triple occupancy rooms, you will need a roommate group of three. For double occupancy rooms, you will need a group of two.
- Wait! Don't update your application on your own! If you update your application, you'll lose your original position when saving it as the newest date. We encourage students to email us at [housing@lynn.edu](mailto:housing@lynn.edu) with any application updates and we will internally update it for you so this does not occur.

End of June: [Housing Assignments Sent Out](#)

- Students will receive their housing assignments via their Lynn email.
- Any student that does not select a roommate by the June 1 deadline will be matched based on the profile questions they answered in their housing application.
- Any student that applies for housing after assignments are sent out will be placed based on availability. Preferences will be taken into consideration but are not guaranteed.
