Please see information below in regards to our Residency Requirement along with the process to be permitted to live off campus.

## Student Residency Requirement

As a residential institution, Lynn University expects students who have completed less than 60 credit hours to live and board within the University residential system. Undergraduate day students with over 60 earned credit hours may request to live in housing owned or controlled by the University however; assignment is based on space availability, which is not guaranteed. All other degree-seeking students may request to live in housing owned or controlled by the University however, assignment is based on space availability, which is not guaranteed and will be given consideration only after the undergraduate day student population has been accommodated.

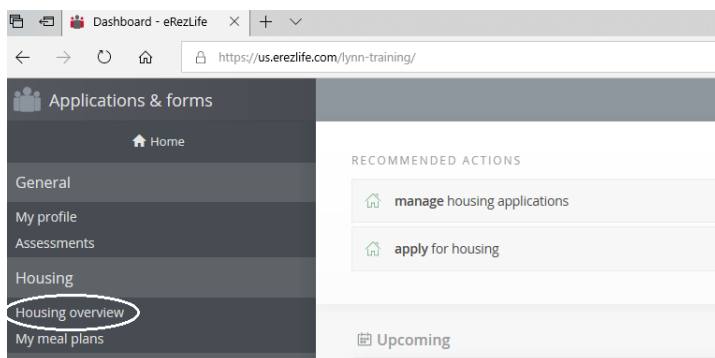
Students meeting any one of the following conditions may be permitted to live off campus:

1. Students 21 years of age or older;
2. Students who are married and/or have children;
3. Students who have completed four (4) semesters of college as a full-time student; and
4. Students residing with their parents or legal guardian within commuting distance of Lynn University. In this circumstance, eligible students will be required to provide a notarized letter from the student's parents or legal guardian stating that the Florida address is the parents' or legal guardian's permanent residence. In addition, a copy of one parent's valid Florida driver's license (which shows proof of Florida residency) is required.

Students interested in requesting to be permitted to live off-campus should complete the following steps.

### To request to be released from housing:

1. Log into your eRezLife account at <https://lynn.erezlife.com>.
  - You must use your Lynn email and password to log in to eRezLife.
2. Select Housing Overview on the left side.
3. Select Apply Now for the Request to be Released from On-Campus Housing Application.
